REGISTRATION

1. Visit www.usef.org, and log in to your US Equestrian account.
2. Click the “My USEF” tab within the top black bar in the top right corner of the screen.
3. Click on the blue tile labeled “Licensed Officials Portal”.
4. Click on the orange tile labeled “Clinic History”
5. Click on the link in red labeled “View/Apply for Upcoming Clinics”.
6. Locate the desired clinic and click the “Apply” button and follow the system prompts.

Online registrations receive immediate confirmation on the web page, no additional email will be sent.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance sheets must be signed at each session to receive credit for the clinic. If you arrive more than one hour later than the scheduled starting time, or leave more than one hour earlier than the scheduled adjournment, you will not receive credit for attending the clinic.

Continuing education credit may be available for physical therapists. If you are interested, contact Amber Braun via email and include which state you are licensed in.

REFUND

If a participant is unable to attend a clinic and notifies US Equestrian of their withdrawal in writing at least seven days prior to the clinic, then 50% of the clinic fee will be refunded less a \$25 processing fee. If a participant withdraws from a clinic, but the position is filled from a waitlist, a full refund will be provided less a \$25 processing fee. If a participant withdraws from a clinic with less than seven days’ notice, the clinic fee is non-refundable regardless of the waitlist status.

FEES

\$400 = if application is received on or before August 16, 2019.

Late Fee
